Declaration of RoHS Compliance and on WEEE Directive

Dear Sir or Madam,

The directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS-II, Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances) restricts the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment. eddylab GmbH is globally active as a manufacturer of sensor technology. The protection of the environment and natural resources is one of our corporate principles, which is why it is a matter of course for us to comply with the environmental objectives of Directive 2011/65/EU. This also includes the extension 2015/863/EU (RoHS-3), which since 22.06.2019 includes an amendment to Annex II of Directive 2011/65/EU.

We can hereby confirm the conformity of our products according to RoHS 2011/65/EU (RoHS-II) and 2015/863/EU (RoHS-3).

The WEEE Directive 2012/19/EU (Waste of Electrical and Electronic Equipment) is an EU directive that regulates the environmentally sound disposal of electrical and electronic equipment. Its aim is to minimize the impact of these devices on the environment and ensure that they are disposed of and recycled properly.

In Germany, manufacturers of electrical and electronic equipment must ensure that they register their products properly and fulfill the corresponding obligations under the WEEE Directive. eddylab GmbH is therefore already registered with the EAR (Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Register) foundation (No. 98484345), which ensures compliance with and implementation of the WEEE Directive.
